Decisions and orders generally directly enforceable without provision of security

Suspension of enforcement possible

until the decision on the objection

≠ Suspensive effect (NO request for suspensive effect possible)

Enforcement at the level of the contracting Member States

Decisions and orders of the Court shall be enforceable in all contracting Member States.

- · Enforcement order shall be attached to the decision.
- Enforcement/enforcement proceedings are governed by the law of the contracting Member State in which enforcement takes place; BUT: without prejudice to the UPCA and the UPC Statute - subsidiarity (extensive suppression).
- In particular for damages, penalty payments and other monetary claims
- EuGVVO ≠ Recognition and enforcement (disputed)
